Late Registration Procedures

2008 – 2009 Season

Late Registration Procedure

Go on-line at www.waa.woodbury.org (select registration) or go to the WAA office (2630 Ojibway Drive) during regular business hours (2pm-6pm). Registration instructions and program formats can also be viewed and printed off of the WAA website listed above and hard copies are available at the WAA building. Remember that there is a \$20 late fee for **each** in-house player (3rd grade and above) and a \$40 late fee for **each** traveling player beginning July 1, 2007. Late fees are non-refundable.

Recreational (In House) Refunds

Parents who choose to withdraw the registration for their child prior to the time their child is placed on a team, regardless of reason, will be issued a full refund minus a \$20 registration-processing fee (late fees are non-refundable). Parents who withdraw the registration for their child after practices have begun, will be issued a prorated refund as deemed appropriate by the girl's or boy's Basketball Director. **Extenuating circumstances**, as deemed appropriate by the girl's or boy's Basketball Director, such as medical reasons (doctor's note required), family moves, etc may warrant a full refund minus a \$20 registration-processing fee (late fees are non-refundable). All refunds will require approximately 4-6 weeks to process.

Traveling Refunds

Once a player is signed up to tryout for a traveling team, only **extenuating circumstances** as deemed appropriate by the girl's or boy's Basketball Director, such as medical reasons (doctor's note required), family move, etc, may warrant a full refund minus a \$20 registration processing fee (late fees are non-refundable). **In no case will any refunds be issued to players who decide to form their own team outside of the WAA.** Registering to play WAA traveling basketball is a high commitment endeavor, not only in time but also in financial resources. If you are considering playing your child elsewhere or withdrawing your child from WAA basketball if they do not qualify for the team that they want to play on, please do not register your child to play WAA traveling basketball.

Those **children who do not make a traveling team** will automatically be guaranteed a place on an in-house team (if there are enough players to form an in-house team at that grade level) and the difference between the two registration fees will be refunded in full. If there are not enough players to form an in-house team at that grade level, a full refund will be issued. If the player decides that they do not want to play on an available in-house team, a full refund will be issued minus a \$20 registration-processing fee if that player is not needed to field a team. Again, **all late fees are non-refundable**. All refunds will require 4-6 weeks to process.
